Everything to Know about Piano Books

Bastien Piano Books

I prefer the Bastien piano methodology to teaching piano than many of the others out there. Especially for beginners. Bastien gets students right into the notes and staff. Other methodologies tend to overemphasize number fingering rather than notes, at the start. I have found that generally this just causes confusion. Often the Bastien piano books have different versions. Whichever one you find is usually fine. Some have a plain white cover with a piano graphic on it. Another one has a colored background with stacked blocks with pictures on them. Either will suit, as long as it says: James Bastien, or Bastien Piano Basics.

Nancy and Randall Faber Books

While the Faber books do not tend to use the teaching methodology I prefer, initially, I do like them at higher levels. They also have a wonderful library of songbooks geared toward learners at each stage. I often utilize their books in the "other" section for early levels, and in "required" from level 3 on.

Additional Piano Music

Aside from Bastien and Faber, I use Schuam, Hal Leonard and other piano instruction composers, and occasionally introduce music from my own collection. Music from my own collection will be photocopied and placed in the student's piano log/binder and he/she is responsible to take care of it (and not lose it). If a student has a desire to play a specific piece of sheet music or movie music, I will research and find those pieces personally and add them to my collection OR the student can buy them.

What to know when buying piano books

<u>Piano books can be found on Amazon, at reasonable prices</u>. Please ensure books are new OR, if used, that you have erased all previous markings or covered them with white out. But if you buy used, please put in the effort to ensure they are "clean", so that past markings will not impact your student. Do not buy books for succeeding levels (2, 3, 4) until notified.

For each level you will find "required" books and "other" books listed below. You *must* purchase the required books for your student based on the level that I assign after our initial meeting. The "other" books are supplemental and therefore optional for you to buy for your student.

Why and when should I invest in supplemental books?

Why? Supplemental books expand the repertoire I have to work with when teaching a student. The more songs available, the easier it is for me to customize the lessons and keep the student engaged and excited about playing. They also get more experience playing and have a more solid foundation when leveling up.

When? Based on our initial meet and greet, I will recommend certain supplemental books based on the goals you and/or your student have for lessons. However, supplemental books do not need to be purchased immediately, and sometimes (depending on the student) it's better to wait a bit before introducing extra material.

One asterisk* = highly recommended for increasing your student's repertoire

Two asterisks** = geared toward ensemble work (playing with instruments and accompanying singers)
